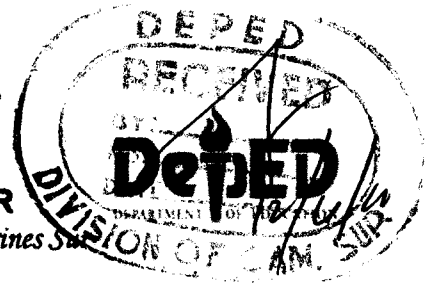

1. This will serve as standing fund of the association to be used for paying taxes and for other worthwhile projects as the officers may propose.
