In consonance with Executive Order Number 26, series 2011 re; National Greening Program this Division announces the Search for Best Gulayan Implementer in the Division of Camarines Sur which will start on February 15, 2016 until March 2016. 4. Every District is required to submit the top three entries for the search. Failure to submit the required number of schools and lack of documents specified in this Memorandum shall be the ground for disqualification. Entry form must be endorsed by the PSDS through letter of intent specifying the result/rank of the top 3 District winners.
5. Forms, criteria and other details can be access/downloaded from DEATA FB Group Accounts.
6. As per Div. Memo. number 139 s. of 2012, re; Implementation of National Greening Program, this office reminds the Teachers, School Heads, and Public Schools District Supervisor to closely support and monitor the status of 10-growing seedling trees as basic requirement for Grade six before he/she can be allowed for Graduation. (Ref. Exec. Order No. 26, s. 2011).
7. All District Elementary Agriculture/Gulayan Coordinators are required to attend the Orientation Conference on January 29, 2016 at Division Office Conference Hall, Freedom Sports Complex, San Jose, Pili, Camarines Sur.
