

**6th DIVISION ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) OUT-OF-SCHOOL YOUTHS / ADULTS
SUMMER ENCAMPMENT**

To: **Public Schools District Supervisors**

1. **The DepEd Alternative Learning System (ALS) of Camarines Sur** will hold the **6th Division Out-of-School Youths (OSY) Summer Encampment** on April 11-13, 2016 at Lagonoy South Central School, Lagonoy, Camarines Sur with the theme "*Ang Liwanag at Sigla ng ALS ay Ramdam sa K to 12*".
2. The summer encampment aims to:
 - a. equip the OSY with life skills (LS) and lifelong learning (LLL) necessary to become effective, efficient and responsive citizens;
 - b. inculcate in the minds of OSY spiritual and moral values;
 - c. strengthen self-reliant, dynamic and creative future leaders to become effective, catalysts/agents of change;
3. Participants in this Division encampment are out-of-school youths/ adults enrolled in any ALS Learning Programs. Education Supervisor I (ALS), Education Program Specialists-ALS, District/School Alternative Learning System Coordinators, Mobile Teachers, Instructional Managers, Facilitators, Volunteers and Interested Stakeholders. A minimum of 10 participants per District is expected to attend.
4. A registration fee of three hundred pesos (P 300.00) per camper shall be collected to cover expenses for training materials, food for the resource speakers, staff and other operational expenses. Transportation, food and other expenses relative to their participation shall be charged against LGU/ SEF/SK/GAD Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The participants are requested to bring the following.
