





SUBJECT: DIVISION IMPLEMENTATION OF BRIGADA ESKWELA 2016

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 35, s. 2016, the Division of Camarines Sur enjoins all public elementary and secondary schools in the implementation of Brigada Eskwela 2016 also known as the National Schools Maintenance from May 30 to June 4, 2016 with the theme "Tayo Para sa Paaralang Ligtas, Maayaos at Handa Mula Kindergarten Hanggang Senior High School."
2. The Division kick-off ceremony and launch of Brigada Eskwela shall be done in each congressional district on May 30 and will be participated by Division Officials assigned in each district, PSDSs, School Heads, PTA, LGUs, and other invited stakeholders. Venue and details will be finalized and announced later.
3. School heads shall take the lead in the planning and observance of the National Schools Maintenance Week at the school level including the pre-implementation activities.
4. All Division and school personnel and other stakeholders are encouraged to take part in the Brigada Eskwela activities and contribute their time and effort and

6. Deadline of submission of reports and entries for the Search for 2016 Brigada Eskwela Best Implementer will be on June 15, 2016.
