**NATIONAL GREENING PROGRAM IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES IN THE  
DIVISION OF CAMARINES SUR**

1. In consonance with Executive Order Number 26, series 2011 re; National Greening Program and with the Republic Act 10068 otherwise known as Organic Agriculture Act of 2010, the Division of Camarines Sur hereby issue the following guidelines for implementation.
  - Integration in the Elementary curricula the importance and concept of Environmental protection, food security, climate change mitigation, waste management, and planting of trees/vegetables.
  - Implementation of Gulayan sa Paaralan Project for every Elementary School is required.
  - Search for greenest, cleanest and best gulayan implementor will be conducted from School, District and Division level for this school year 2012-2013.
  - Every Graduating Grade Six pupil this school year shall plant, nurture and maintain the growth of at least 10 fruit bearing trees/forest trees. Certification on the status of trees planted by Grade VI pupil as basic requirement for graduation shall be issued by the Barangay Captain duly corroborated by their parent and attested by their respective adviser.
  - The project "Bawat Mag Aaral Isang Puno Project" is still in effect for Grades One to Five Pupils.
  - Executive Order No. 26 section 3, 3.1 requires all teachers and non Teaching Personnel to plant a minimum of ten (10) seedling trees per year inside the school premises or within their community.
2. Teachers, School Heads, PSDS, Division Program Supervisor and Division Coordinators are required to implement, support and monitor the status of this tangible project.
3. Certification Form, Criteria for Best Gulayan sa Paaralan, Steps/procedures for tree planting, Excerpts of Executive Order number 26, s. 2011, excerpts of RA 10068 are hereby provided in the enclosure.
4. Immediate dissemination and compliance of this Memorandum is desired.
