REGIONAL TRAINING OF SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS

To: Public Schools District Supervisors

1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 119, s. 2012, the **Department of Education, Regional Office V** and **Bicol Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (BAESPA)** shall conduct a three-day **Regional Training of Elementary School Paper Advisers** at RELC Conference Hall, Legazpi City on October 15-17, 2012.

The activity aims to enhance the skills of school paper advisers on the basic features of campus journalism such as news writing, feature writing, editorial writing, copy reading and headline writing and street photography, and strengthen their commitment in the promotion of campus journalism in Bicol Region.
