

1. The Division of Camarines Sur is holding the Division Festival of Talents (Elementary Science) for public and private schools with the theme, "2012 Division Festival of Talents, Elementary Science: A Tribute to Bicolano Learner and Teachers", on November 22-23, 2012 at Sipocot North Central School, Sipocot District, Sipocot, Camarines Sur.
 2. The Objectives are the following:
 1. Show pupils performance and products as evidences of their learning.
 2. Enhance pupils level of confidence and competence through friendly competitions.
 3. Recognize teacher and their outstanding contributions to the field of literacy and education
 3. Participants to their festival are the District first and second place winners in the following events:
 - Science Fair (Individual/Team) - Grade V-VI
 - Science Quiz - Grade III-VI
 - Sci-art Contest - Grade III-VI
 - Science Journalism - Grade VorVI
 - Science Action Research - Teachers
 4. **Mechanics**, guidelines and criteria for judging in all events and schedules of contests are found in Enclosure 1 and 2.
 5. This is a live-out activity and participants are advised to bring meals. However, participants from district who wish to stay at the venue may call Sipocot North Central School.
 6. Travel expenses and registration fee of Php. 50.00 per contestant and per coach for supplies, contest materials and honoraria of judges and other needs shall be charged against local/school funds or other available sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
